As always, I'm thrilled to welcome you to another unforgettable summer of learning, friendship and adventure in the stunning surroundings of Sedbergh.



Elite Sports Courses

Available in Weeks 5 and 6

New for 2026, pupils aged 11 to 15 will have the opportunity to take part in our Elite Sports Courses run by former Olympians and international sportsmen and women.

Over a period of 4 days, children will be mixed with British pupils from schools around the UK for their chosen sport and within the boarding houses.

Available in weeks 5 and 6, children can choose from football, hockey, athletics, rugby and netball. During the course, they will also enjoy 2 excursions per week.



English + Outdoor Adventure

At Sedbergh, the fells, hills, lakes, and rivers provide the backdrop for adventure and discovery.

Our exciting outdoor adventure programme challenges both body and mind, taking full advantage of the stunning natural landscape that surrounds us with pupils engaging in a variety of thrilling activities including abseiling, caving, climbing, kayaking and ghyll scrambling.

Whether you're navigating rugged hills, paddling across serene lakes or abseiling down a waterfall, this course provides an unforgettable experience, connecting you to nature as you grow in confidence developing resilience, teamwork, and leadership skills supported by our team of experts.

Future Founders (NEW FOR 2026)

Dream it. Build it. Launch it.

Designed for students aged 14–17, Future Founders invites young entrepreneurs to design and promote their own business idea, from initial concept to full launch. This innovative programme introduces the exciting world of business, creativity, and entrepreneurship. Working in teams, students explore marketing, budgeting, branding, and digital communication, learning how imagination, strategy, and collaboration can turn bold ideas into real success stories.

Morning sessions focus on developing ideas and practical skills. Building on the foundations of the LIRA programme, Future Founders includes workshops and activities such as:

- Exploring how AI and technology are transforming business.
- Learning coding and innovation techniques to bring ideas to life.
- Developing leadership and teamwork through real-world business challenges.
- Understanding social media, branding, and mental health in modern enterprise. Investigating global business and interviewing local entrepreneurs.
- Attending guest workshops from local professionals and business owners.

Students join the wider summer school community for afternoon and evening activities, including sports, excursions, and social events, allowing them to connect with peers from around the world while practising their English in authentic, informal settings. Selected afternoons feature additional business workshops and project work.

Excursions bring learning beyond the classroom, including a negotiation challenge that will boost quick-thinking creativity. The course culminates in an exciting Dragon's Den-style finale, where students pitch their ideas to a panel of judges.

Future Founders inspires creativity, confidence, and collaboration, giving students the mindset and skills to become the leaders and innovators of tomorrow.





EXCURSIONS & TRIPS

With 3 excursions each week, pupils experience British culture first hand as they visit well known British cities across the North of England. Manchester, York, Edinburgh and Liverpool feature in our programme alongside world renowned landmarks and visitor attractions such as the Lake District National Park, Chester Zoo, Grizedale Forest and Manchester City Football Club.

Pupils will enjoy a wide variety of exciting experiences in one of the most remarkable areas of the British Isles. Our unique location provides an opportunity to explore both historical and modern landmarks throughout Northern England.

Each week, students embark on one full-day city excursion and two half-day trips, immersing themselves in British culture through visits to iconic cities, world-class heritage sites, and popular attractions. Traveling by coach with a packed lunch, pupils are encouraged to engage fully in each excursion, with additional resources such as leaflets, treasure hunts, information packs, and maps provided to enhance their experience.

Excursions typically depart at 9 am (earlier when travelling further from the school) and return by dinner. After a full-day trip, students can unwind in the evening with a relaxed movie night and snacks.





ENGLISH LESSONS

A Summer School Built Around You

With a minimum of 15 hours of formal English lessons each week, pupils are placed onto the Junior (Ages 8-11) or Senior Course (Ages 12-16). All Sedbergh teaching staff are experienced, enthusiastic native level speakers and our 1:15 teacher-pupil ratio ensures pupils benefit from their teacher's dedicated time and attention.

Pupils complete a short placement test in advance of arrival, the results of which enable teachers to allocate them to the most appropriate class for their ability. Lessons feature a diverse mix of nationalities with classes based on pre-course assessments of grammar, vocabulary, and speaking ability.

Formal lessons are timetabled on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings. Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays are excursion days.

Our syllabus, grounded in the latest research in young learner language education, adopts a dynamic, communicative approach to encourage pupils to engage with one another and Sedbergh staff in English as much as possible. Our curriculum aligns with CEFR guidelines, focusing on the four core skills: reading, listening, speaking, and writing. CEFR descriptors are used to help pupils develop the skills and knowledge required for effective communication in English and weekly collaborative projects help students develop valuable life skills, such as research, presentation, negotiation, and debating skills.

Lesson materials are provided and include customised materials tailored to the needs of each student. A detailed report is provided outlining the pupils' progress and English level at the end of the course.

Community Engagement

Pupils will have the opportunity to engage with our local and wider communities, visiting our neighbouring towns and engaging in specific activities that have been developed to encourage our pupils to practice their newly acquired language skills.

A HOME AWAY FROM HOME

No matter how far you have travelled, you will soon feel at home in our relaxed, comfortable boarding houses. Each house is well equipped with its own common room, satellite TV, games, WiFi and a range of single, twin and multi-bedrooms. A full laundry service is provided twice weekly.

Everyone at Sedbergh is committed to establishing a safe and homely environment. Our pupil's wellbeing is paramount and we want you to return home with lots of wonderful memories. Boarding Houses on both campuses are welcoming and comfortable and feel like a real 'home from home'. Our live-in house parents achieve this by creating a fun, friendly community where every child feels safe, secure and valued. Medical needs are dealt with by our Welfare Officers who are on hand 24 hours a day with support from our dedicated school nursing staff and local medical centre.

Challenge Your Taste Buds

We are proud of our excellent catering staff, superb on-site dining facilities and the varied, international-style menu provided by our own team of in-house chefs. All tastes and dietary requirements are catered for with meals cooked in house by our in-house catering teams and served within the house dining room.

A range of hot and cold dishes, including vegetarian options and a salad bar, are available at breakfast, lunch and dinner.





ESCORTED ARRIVALS & TRANSFERS

By Air

Pupils will be met on arrival at the airport by a member of staff. Once within our care, pupils will be provided with refreshments before being transferred from the airport to Sedbergh via our fleet of minibuses or via transport arranged by our in-house transport department.

Escorted return transfers are provided at a cost of £75.00, when arriving on the designated arrival and departure dates from Manchester and Liverpool airports. Transfers outside these times and from other airports can be arranged at an additional cost.

By Rail

Oxenholme Lake District station can be reached by direct train from the following cities:

London: 2 hours 40 mins

Manchester: 1 Hour 20 mins.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is included in the cost?

The weekly cost of the course covers all accommodation, meals, English lessons, all sports and activities, excursions, internet access, laundry service and a certificate and report.

Does my child require a VISA?

Please follow the link to the GOV.UK website to find out if your child will need a visa to attend Sedbergh International Summer School. In the event that a Visa is required, we will be able to provide you with a letter confirming your child's visit to the UK in order to study at Sedbergh International Summer School.

How does my child get from and to the airport?

The school provides airport transfers every Saturday from Manchester International Airport, the return cost for which is included in the £75.00 transfer fee provided that pupils arrive between the hours of 8am and 6pm. Transfers from other airports may be available upon request for an increased fee.

Where does my child live and who will look after my child?

Sedbergh School is renowned for its pastoral care, this is replicated during the ISS. Boys and girls live separately in one of our beautiful boarding houses. Staff provide a happy, supportive environment for your child during their stay and pupils are looked-after by an experienced team of staff including a Houseparent, Assistant House Parent, support staff and the welfare team.

What does my child need to bring with them?

Clothing should be casual, practical, machine washable and labelled with their name. The average temperature during July is between 16 – 23 degrees. Your child should come prepared for both warm and cool weather. Bedlinen and bath towels are provided but your child should bring a swimming towel with them. A detailed kit list is provided in the Student Handbook.

How can I send Pocket Money?

The best and safest way to provide pocket money is with a prepaid cash card (most commonly Visa or Mastercard). Alternatively, pupils may use their phone with a credit/debit card uploaded onto it.

My child has specific dietary/medical requirements. Can Sedbergh ISS cater for this?

Absolutely! Parents must ensure that we are informed of any needs prior to arrival. These can be recorded on the dietary/medical form provided upon receipt of your booking.
