Sports and games equipment – tennis rackets, footballs, etc	Some provided by main Senior/Prep Schools, some bought from online retailers such as Amazon, some bought from retailers such as Sports Direct.	£200 - £300	Annually

Snacks, refreshments and prizes (e.g. popcorn for movie night)	Pound Land and other retailers such as WH Smith, when not being provided by school. Where possible, sourced through the catering department (e.g. hot chocolate for houses, food/drink for themed events or discos) to reduce costs by buying wholesale.	£100 - £150	Annually
